Cricket

Atkinson, Morgan, Vaughton and Harris Ovals (All schools responsible)

Format

Boys – 10 over per side matches

Girls – 7 over per side matches

Equipment

Boys – first named team to provide a 2-piece red 156gm cricket ball to be used for both innings of the game. A new will be used for each game.

Girls – Pulteney to provide modified 'incredi-balls' for use in all matches.

Umpiring

Each team to provide an umpire for their team's matches.

Scoring

Each team to provide a scorer (can be a student). Pulteney to provide scoresheets, clipboards and pens for each team.

Pulteney to set up grounds – stumps, boundaries, marquees, scorer's table, chairs and scoreboards.

St John's Belair to organise a controlling umpire for each diamond. Each team to have one person to serve as first base umpire for their fielding innings.

Pulteney to set up diamonds – bases, benches, marquees and provide water.

Teams

Mixed teams of 10 players. Ideally teams would be split 5-5, 6-4 or 4-6 in terms of boys-girls.

Format

All matches to be best of 3 sets, first to 11 points. Must have an advantage of at least 2 points to win the set.

Each fixture to be decided by the result of the singles matches plus the doubles matches.

Eg The Pulteney vs Pedare fixture is made up of 15 matches: Ten singles matches. Five doubles matches.

The combined results from these 15 matches determines the winner. Eg if Pulteney wins six matches and Pedare wins nine matches, Pedare win the fixture.

Umpiring

Players to umpire their own matches.

Equipment

Pulteney to provide table tennis balls for all matches. Teams to bring their own bats.

Format

Four boys and four girls from each school.

All matches to be played as the best of three short sets (first to 4 games).

Each fixture to be decided by the result of the singles matches plus the doubles matches.

Eg The Pulteney vs Pedare Boys fixture is made up of 6 matches: Four singles matches. Two doubles matches.

The combined results from these 6 matches determines the winner of the fixture. Eg if Pulteney wins two matches and Pedare wins four matches, Pedare would win the fixture. (Results determined on total wins not sets).
