ELC & Reception Uniform (year round)



ELC UNIFORM

- Knitted stripe polo t-shirt
- Knitted stripe polo long-sleeved (optional)
- Pulteney sport shorts
- Pulteney trackpants (cold weather option)
- Navy skivvy (optional)
- White socks
- White sandshoes (preferable)
- Navy sandals (warm weather option)
- Pulteney play hat required for outside play
- Additional optional items listed below

RECEPTION & MID-YEAR RECEPTION UNIFORM

Ideally, students in Reception and Mid-Year Reception will wear the Pulteney PE uniform as outlined below. Students entering Reception or Mid-Year Reception may continue to wear their ELC uniform, however, it is preferable that once they start school, students transition to wearing the PE uniform.

PE Uniform:

- Short sleeve polo (unisex, in navy or white)
- Sports shorts (unisex)
- Skort (optional)
- Pulteney rugby top
- Pulteney trackpants (cold weather option)
- White socks
- White sandshoes
- Pulteney play hat required for recess, lunch and PE

Additional:

- · School bag
- Art smock

ADDITIONAL OPTIONAL ITEMS - ELC & RECEPTION

- Pulteney navy skivvy
- Pulteney rugby top
- Pulteney trackpants
- Pulteney puffa jacket
- Pulteney puffa vest





IMPORTANT - When the UV rating is 3 or above:

- Reception & Mid-Year Reception students are required to wear their play hat during recess, lunch, and PE lessons.
- ELC students are required to wear their play hat during outdoor play and outdoor learning activities.

Junior School Girls' Winter Academic Uniform



YEAR I - YEAR 6 GIRLS' WINTER ACADEMIC UNIFORM TERM 2 & 3

COMPULSORY

- Blazer
- Long-sleeve blouse
- Tunic (pinafore) or navy skirt (from Year 4)
- Ladies' academic trouser (alternative to skirt/tunic)
- · School tie
- White socks or navy tights (with tunic/skirt)
- Grey socks (if wearing trousers)
- Black school shoes (eg Mary Janes)
- Woolen jumper (optional)
- Woolen vest (optional)
- Woolen cardigan (optional)

OTHER ITEMS

- School bag
- Play hat (bucket hat or broad brim hat) compulsory
- View additional optional garments on page 7

- The Pulteney blazer is mandatory for all students from Years 1 to 12 during the winter uniform period (Terms 2 and 3). It must be worn to and from School each day as the primary outer garment.
- For additional warmth, students may wear the woolen jumper or vest underneath their blazers.
- Play hats are required to be worn every day at school during Recess and Lunch when the UV rating is 3 or above.
- Girls' dresses and skirts must be no more than 3cm above or below mid-knee.
- School shoes should be Mary Janes or classic black shoes; black sneakers are not acceptable with the winter uniform.

YEAR 1 - YEAR 6 BOYS' WINTER ACADEMIC UNIFORM TERM 2 & 3

COMPULSORY

- Blazer (to be worn to/from School)
- Academic trousers or academic shorts
- Long sleeve shirt
- School tie
- Grey socks
- Black school shoes*
- Woolen jumper (optional)
- Woolen vest (optional)
- Woolen cardigan (optional)

OTHER ITEMS

- School bag
- Play hat (bucket hat or broad brim hat) compulsory
- View additional optional garments on page 7

- Black school shoes
- Woolen jumper (optional)
- Woolen vest (optional)
- Woolen cardigan (optional)

- View additional optional garments on page 7

COMPULSORY

- Blazer
- Academic trousers or academic short (grey or stone)
- Long-sleeve shirt
- · School tie
- · Grey socks
- Woolen jumper (optional)
- Woolen vest (optional)
- Woolen cardigan (optional)

OTHER ITEMS

- · School bag
- Cap, bucket hat or broad brim hat
- View additional optional garments on page 7

- The Pulteney blazer is mandatory for all students from Years 1 to 12 during the winter uniform period (Terms 2 and 3). It must be worn to and from School each day as the primary outer garment.

ACADEMIC OPTIONAL PIECES

These items can be worn as part of the academic uniform for added warmth and comfort but should be worn beneath the blazer when worn outside of School or when going to/from School:

- Woolen jumper
- Woolen vest
- Woolen cardigan
- Cap
- · Broad brim hat
- Bucket hat

CASUAL OPTIONAL PIECES

These items are for casual wear and may be worn with the academic/winter uniform during school hours on campus, or with the sports uniform.

They should not be worn off campus or as part of the formal uniform:

- Soft shell jacket
- Puffa jacket
- Puffa vest
- Scarf
- Beanie
- Visor

PLEASE NOTE

The blazer must be worn to and from school every day as the primary outer garment. If additional warmth is needed, students may wear the optional woolen jumper or vest underneath their blazers.

Casual optional items, such as the soft shell jacket, puffa jacket, and puffa vest, may be worn during school hours on school premises with the academic/winter uniform or with the sports uniform, but are not considered official outerwear and should not be worn off campus.

PULTENEY GRAMMAR SCHOOL UNIFORM DRESS CODE & APPEARANCE

DRESS CODE:

- 1. All students are to wear the school uniform correctly and adhere to the school dress code.
- 2. The prescribed uniform must be worn for sport.
- 3. Hair is to be conservatively cut and must not fall across the eyes or below the collar. Shoulder-length hair must be tied back with ribbons, hair ties, or clips. There should be no extremes of colour or length; hair colour should be natural. Clippered cuts should be no shorter than a No. 2.
- 4. Girls' dresses and skirts must be no more than 3 cm above or below mid-knee.
- 5. School shoes must be classic black shoes that are polished and in good repair. Black sneakers are not acceptable with the summer or winter uniform.
- 6. Jewellery is not part of the school uniform and should not be worn to school or any school activity. Earrings may be worn as one small gold, pearl, or silver stud or a gold or silver sleeper in each ear lobe. Necklaces may only be worn if of religious significance.
- 7. Make-up, nail polish, and other adornments are not to be worn.
- 8. Facial hair is not permitted, and students should be clean-shaven.

PULTENEY BLAZER & OUTERWEAR REQUIREMENTS

At Pulteney Grammar School, blazers are mandatory for all students from Years 1 to 12 when wearing the winter uniform (Terms 2 and 3). The blazer should be worn to and from school every day as the primary outer garment. If additional warmth is needed, students may wear the optional woolen jumper or vest underneath their blazers. Optional items such as the soft shell jacket, puffa jacket, and puffa vest should only be worn on school premises and are not considered official outerwear. The blazer must always be accompanied by a Pulteney tie when worn with the winter uniform.

In addition to daily wear during winter, blazers should also be worn at assemblies, official events, excursions (unless otherwise specified), and when students are outside of school in the formal uniform.

During Terms 1 and 4, when the summer uniform is worn, the blazer must be worn to formal assemblies and official occasions as directed by the Principal. If the forecast indicates a temperature of 35 degrees Celsius or higher, blazers need not be worn.

Junior School (Years 1–6) Specific Requirements: Junior School students who have PE on the day do not need to wear the formal uniform to Junior School assemblies or chapel services. However, for full school formal assemblies, including the start and end of term assemblies, the formal uniform must be worn.

This guide provides information about the requirements of the Pulteney winter uniform. The information is correct at the time of printing, 1 April 2025.
