

Lead by example in creating and coordinating service projects, mentor younger students, and strengthen community links, ensuring service efforts add to Rungie House points.







MIDDLE SCHOOL STUDENT LEADER

This is a key senior Middle School leadership role, open exclusively to Year 9 students. Two students from each House will be elected to represent their peers. STUDENT VOICE COMMITTEE (YR 7- YR 11)

The Student Voice Committee (Yr 7- Yr 11) is made up of Student Voice Representatives elected from each Tutor group across all Houses. This group brings together students from Year 7 to Year 11 and provides an important platform for feedback, ideas, and collaboration. Our Year 12 Prefects will also join committee meetings. Committee members meet regularly to discuss student perspectives and share these with staff and leadership. As a combined team, they also present ideas for change and improvement, ensuring the voices of all Tutor groups contribute to shaping the learning and wellbeing culture of the Secondary School.
