### Basketball Rules:

- Clock stops for all timeouts - regardless of when this is taken (within a 10-point margin)
- Clock stops in the last minute of the second half (within a 10-point margin) for all whistles
- Timeouts do not carry over - 1 timeout per half regardless - Help keep games on time
- If a timeout is taken in the last minute the ball can be advanced to the front court if in the offensive team's possession

### Teams

Mixed teams of 8 players - Ideally teams would be split 4-4, 5-3 or 3-5 in terms of boys-girls.

### Rules

Made up of 4 doubles, 8 singles, 8 reverse singles (no reverse doubles)

Doubles – 1,2 v 1,2 3,4 v 3,4 5,6 v 5,6 7,8 v 7,8 = Total of 4 Games

Singles – 1 v 1, 2 v 2, 3 v 3, 4 v 4, 5 v 5, 6 v 6, 7 v 7, 8 v 8 = Total of 8 Games

Reverse Singles - 1 v 2, 2 v 1, 3 v 4, 4 v 3, 5 v 6, 6 v 5, 7 v 8, 8 v 7 = Total of 8 Games

Games to 11 points

Best of 3 sets with points advantage

### Points

2 points awarded to the winning school for each match. For example:

If Pedare defeat Woodcroft 11 games to 9, Pedare receive 2 points

### Umpiring

Players to umpire their own matches.

### Equipment

Pulteney to provide table tennis balls for all matches. Teams to bring their own bats.



## Coordinating School

- Each of the participating schools has been allocated a sport:
  - Basketball: St John's
  - Football: Pulteney
  - Soccer: Pedare
  - Netball: Woodcroft
  - Hockey: Pulteney
  - Table Tennis: Pulteney
- The school will:
  - Provide match balls for that sport.
  - Provide/source suitably qualified umpires/referees for that sport.
  - **Enter their sports results and fair play awards after each round into shared document.**

## Scoring System

Please enter all results into shared document.

The coordinating school of the sport must enter the results of each game into the shared document.

- Win: 2 points
- Draw: 1 point
- Loss: 0 points
- Forfeited against: 1 point
- **Scores to be entered after each round into shared doc.** Via text to home school scorer.

## Fair Play Awards

Awarded in each sport to the player who best demonstrates the following values:

- Competes to the spirit as well as the laws of the game.
- 'Fills' the emotional tanks of teammates.
- Respectful of and towards opponents and officials.

Coaches of **both teams** are to come together upon conclusion of each game and collectively decide on the top three players in the game (from either team) and award 3,2,1 'Fair Play' Points.

## Catering

Pulteney will run a BBQ with food and drinks at moderate cost. All staff, students and parents are invited to use the Pulteney Shop (open all day for food and coffee) or to make their own arrangements for the day.

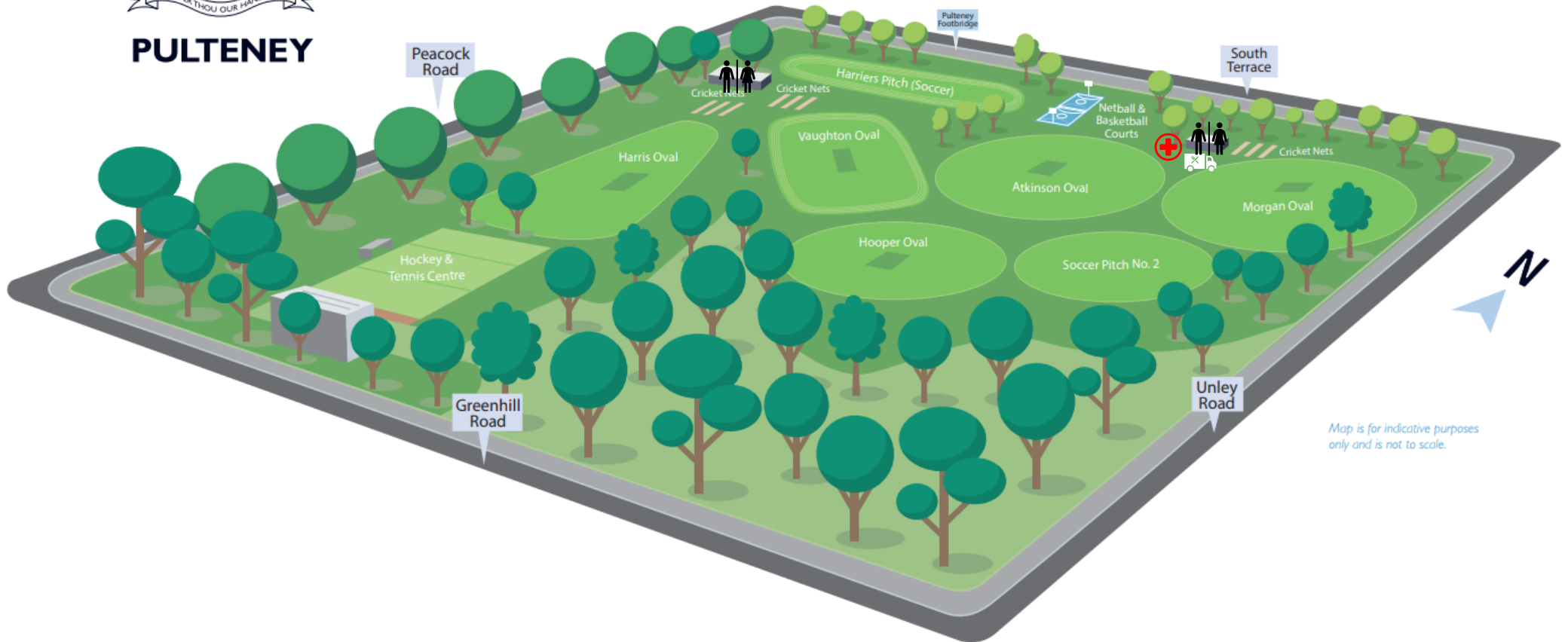
