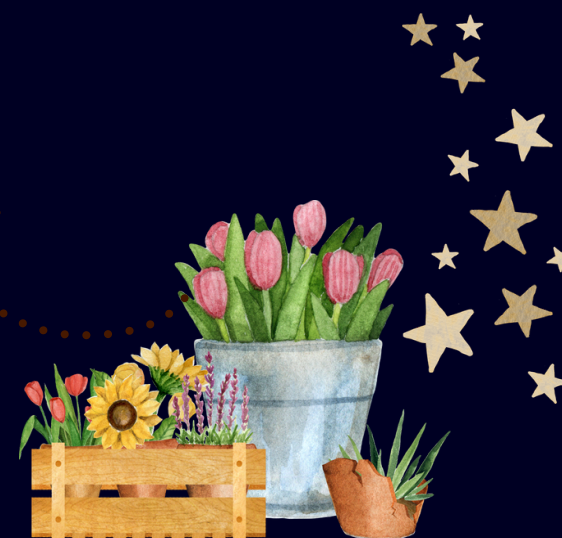

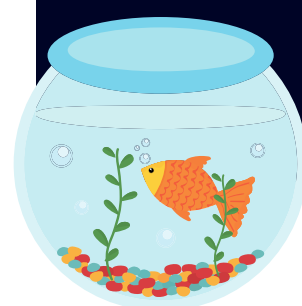


Tuesday 6th October

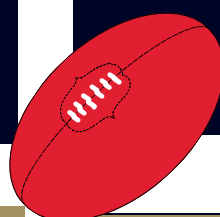

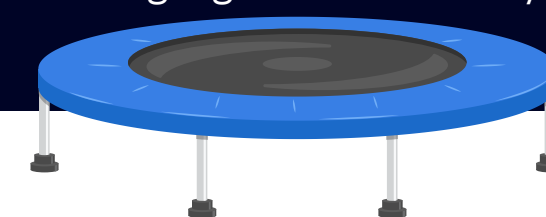


Thursday 8th October

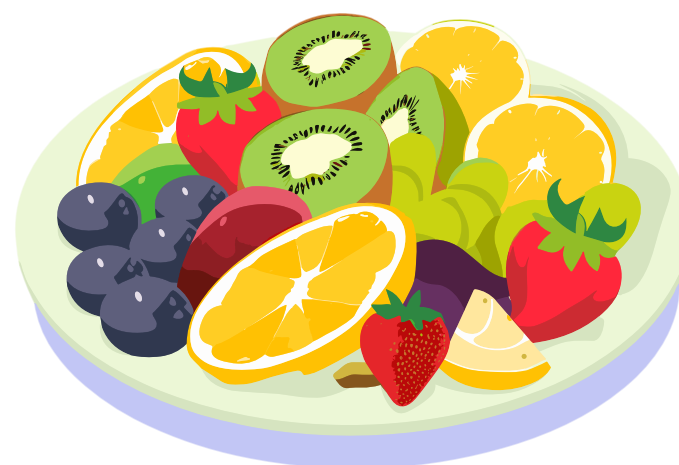
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KEY INFORMATION

Bus Departure

For most Excursions, we will leave Pulteney Grammar School by bus around 9:15am. However, Wood house will require a prompt departure time of 9am. Other Excursion times will vary throughout the Vacation Care Program so please ensure to check the itinerary and any announcements for different departure and arrival times.



Wrist Bands

For all Excursions, students are given a wristband to wear for identification purposes and any relevant medical requirements



Clothing

We strongly encourage all students to wear their Pulteney Grammar School Sports Uniform on Excursion days. On other Vacation Care days, they may wear either casual clothing or the sports Uniform. All clothing must be clearly named and comply with weather conditions. Bike Helmets are also to be clearly labelled. *Although Autumn has arrived, please remember to pack a suitable sun hat each day your student attends. Sunscreen will be re-applied through out the day when the UV levels reach 3 and above.

Medical and Dietary Information

MEDICATION: If your child has up-to-date medication stored at OSHC, our team will access this as required by the Medical Action Plan. Please ensure any additional medication is packed each day your child attends and inform one of our OSHC Educators at drop off.

DIETARY: Our OSHC service ensures all food provided for afternoon tea meets any dietary requirements of our children.

Vacation Care Booking Form

We encourage families and caregivers to read the Terms and Conditions of the Vacation Care Booking Form carefully. Information around cancellations and additional fees, clothing and sun safety, and excursion requirements are included within the booking form.

Please be sure to read the relevant Risk Assessments for each Incursion and Excursion which can be accessed via the Parent Portal under the OSHC Vacation Care tab. Feel free to speak to a member of our Leadership Team if you have any questions around this.

Cancellations in Vacation Care

As per our Fees Policy (available in the Factory or upon request), *cancellations for Vacation Care bookings should be made by close of business **five days prior** to avoid being charged full sessional fees.*

- Cancellations made with **less than 5 business days' notice** will incur full sessional fees.
- Cancellations made with **more than 5 business days' notice** will incur 50% of the sessional fee for that day.

Booking fees during Vacation Care are unable to be modified or cancelled after closure of the booking period, hence **all bookings during Vacation Care are considered as a commitment to that booking** (unless a medical certificate is provided). **Please note this cancellation policy is different to Term-Time cancellations.**
